**Comment:** George Frideric Handel, born in Halle, grew up as the son

of a barber-surgeon who wanted his boy to study law. Young Handel successfully rebelled, and by 1703 was playing violin and keyboard in Hamburg's opera orchestra. Handel spent four years it Italy (1706-1710), where he moved amidst the musical elite of the day – meeting Corelli, Scarlatti, and Pasquini – and received the nickname il caro Sassone (the dear Saxon).
